Your **English** summary for the World JOTA-JOTI Report:

From Norway 3525 scouts and guides were reported to have participated in 58th JOTA – 19th JOTI 2015 with 42 stations active in JOTA operated by a total of 56 radio amateurs; and 58 JOTI bases were active.

A Nordic Puzzle for this was made for this year's JOTA-JOTI by Rolf Marthin Nilsen (LA2KLA), and spread to all the Nordic countries. The puzzle was built upon exchanging codes with dashes and dots, making a final morse code greeting: "WE WISH ALL SCOUTS AND GUIDES A NICE JOTA JOTI". A Nordic JOTA-JOTI badge was also made, this year with a purple background color →.



As part of Nordic coordination there are opening ceremonies for each Nordic country run sequentially on the 80 m scout frequency. The Norwegian official opening was conducted by the JOTA-2015 Headquarters station LA4JAM operated by the NJO LA4LN. The opening speech was given by the Norwegian International Commissioner Henrik Vagle Dalsgaard. LA4JAM contacted a number of special JOTA stations, among them HB9S (operated by Yves, HB9AOF, the old friend since LC1J at NORDJAMB-75 in Norway 40 years ago), SU8JOTA, and TC58JOTA.

In general the NJO has the impression that all participating scouts had a good time. In addition to the many contacts with other scouts via radio or internet, a number of scout units had special activities like radio direction finding, electronic kit-building, signalling, outdoors activities, and some had historic activities related to the 70th anniversary for the liberation of Norway after WW2 (after 5 years of occupation by the nazis 1940-1945).

The present NJO had only been NJO for less than 2 months before this JOTA-JOTI (although was NJO 1975-1978). Hence most of the JOTA organization had been performed already by The YWCA-YMCA Scouts of Norway administration office, by the clever work of Solfrid Elisabeth Boehler.
